

History:

Consistently, statistics from the SC Office of the State Fire Marshal shows that more than 75% of fire deaths occur in the home. These findings are echoed by similar statistics at the national level. The place that our citizens should feel the safest, is where they are most likely to suffer a life loss due to the tragedy of fire.

Vision:

The SC Firefighters' Association is home of the SC Fire Sprinkler Coalition and supports its efforts in educating the public, home builders, developers, and other stakeholders about the availability, affordability, and the life-saving ability of residential fire sprinklers. The SC State Firefighters' Association, the SC Fire Sprinkler Coalition, the SC Fire & Life Safety Education Association, and its other partners, affirms its commitment to seeing residential fire sprinklers installed in all newly constructed One- and Two-Family Dwellings.
