Get ready for Fire Prevention Week in October

The <u>National Fire Protection Association</u> is celebrating *100 years* of making communities safer through its Fire Prevention Week campaign. The organization announced last week its theme for 2022 Fire Prevention Week is **Fire Won't Wait. Plan Your Escape.**

According to a <u>press release</u> from the <u>National Volunteer Fire Council</u>, the theme "promotes potentially life-saving messages that can mean the

difference between life and death in a fire. Developing a home escape plan with all members of the household and practicing it regularly ensures that everyone knows what to do when the smoke alarm sounds and uses that time wisely."

Reminder: SC Firefighter Healthcare Benefit Plan now available

The South Carolina Firefighter Cancer Health Care Benefit Plan became effective July 1, 2021. The legislature appropriated funding in the FY 2021-2022 budget for State Fire to purchase an insurance policy to provide the benefits defined in the statute. After a competitive bidding process, managed by the South Carolina Division of Procurement Services, the contract for the insurance policy was awarded to AXIS Insurance Company. AXIS will be utilizing Provident Agency, Inc., for claims management and processing and the South Carolina Firefighters Insurance Services for local claims assistance.
