A different type of bucket brigade

The Cancer Coalition in partnership with State Fire last week filled 500 decon buckets to give to fire departments across South Carolina.

"This has been a long time coming," said **Tracy Williams**, chair of the Health & Safety Committee and member of the Cancer Coalition.

"We knew we had funds through grants and once we determined we wanted to do decon buckets, it was a matter of COVID hitting and the supply chain slowing the process," Williams continued. "But through the help of our coalition partners, we were able to secure, store, and stuff those items."

Included in the buckets: decon wipes, brush, trash bags, tape, dish soap, spray bottle, reducer, hose, spray nozzle, Y adapter, and a flyer with a QR code that leads to information on decon and cancer reduction information.

FEMA: Free training on lithium-ion battery

fires

A new 1-hour online course from Underwriters Laboratories' Fire Safety Research Institute (FSRI) aims to help firefighters understand *how hazards develop during lithium-ion battery incidents*. The training is supported by video footage from FSRI's experiments with the batteries to illustrate the hazards in action.

According to the objectives of the course, firefighters who take the course will be able to:

- Describe the construction of lithium-ion cells and identify the unique characteristics of lithium-ion batteries.
- List the reasons lithium-ion batteries fail and explain the process of thermal runaway.
- Describe the fire and explosion hazards resulting from thermal runaway propagation in lithium-ion batteries.
- Develop strategies to reduce the risk associated with thermal runaway, including fire and explosion hazards.

Legislative Upate

Each week when the legislature is in session, Association lobbyists Stewart, Konduros, and Associates provide an update on legislation that impacts the fire service. All Legislative Updates for current session are posted on our <u>website</u>.

Today we're looking at 109.16 Active First Responder Tax Credit.

The Executive Budget recommends adding this new proviso creating a \$2,000 income tax credit for tax year 2023 to active sworn law enforcement officers, firefighters and emergency medical technicians. View the Governor's Executive Budget.
