Deadline to apply for OA 23-02 is June 30

The deadline to apply for Fire Officer Academy: The Company Officer class 23-02 is Friday, June 30 at midnight. This is an intense weeks-long program not designed for the complacent.

The applicant pool is growing and the program is limited to 25 students. Do not wait to submit your information to be considered!

Note that an application is required, including a resume, cover letter, and letter from the applicant's Chief. Applicants do not need to be a member of the South Carolina State Firefighters' Association Officers Section but membership with the Officers Section is preferred. Applications will be vetted prior to being accepted into the program and will be sent precourse assignments to be completed prior to final selection.

Gary Rogers retires as Association Chaplain

Reverend **Gary Rogers** retired as Chaplain of the South Carolina State Firefighters' Association at the conclusion of Fire-Rescue on June 17. Chaplain Rogers served the state for 13 years in the chaplain role and has played an instrumental role in advancing the role of chaplaincy in the South Carolina fire service. Chaplain Rogers was inducted into the Hall of Fame for his efforts over the last decade plus.

"We spend a lot of time in the fire service looking for the ideal leader...we've got that, in my mind, in Gary Rogers," Association Executive Director **Joe Palmer** said.

"I have been tremendously honored," Chaplain Rogers stated. "I have been the most surprised person in the state of South Carolina that I got chosen to be the chaplain for the South Carolina State Firefighters' Association, to get to do what I have been able to do... and I just want to say thank you for trusting me in this role and allowing me to do what I get to do."
