The program offers first responders *free* will preparation services. It is very important that every first responder has a will and healthcare advanced directive. We encourage spouses to participate too. If you do not have either, please take advantage of the Wills for Heroes Program on <a href="Thursday July 25">Thursday July 25</a>, <a href="2024">2024</a> from 9:30a to 1:00pm at the law offices of Nelson Mullins, 1320 Main St., Suite 1700, Columbia. You must make an appointment and schedule a time.

If you would like to have a will or power of attorney drawn up *free of charge* please complete the process below:

Please attempt to make your appointment by <a href="mailto:July 19">July 19</a>. Appointments fill up fast, so please book in advance.
- After your appointment is made, we will email you a questionnaire to complete.
   Your spouse will receive a questionnaire too. Please bring the completed
   questionnaire with you to your appointment to assist with preparing your will.
- 3. This clinic is unable to serve persons with large or complicated estates, those who want to set up sophisticated trusts, those who have beneficiaries (e.g., a spouse or children) who are on needs-based assistance (such as SSI disability or Medicaid), or those who would like to exclude their spouse from the will.
- 4. This program is very popular, and we have limited appointments. If you cannot make your appointment, please let us know right away so we can schedule someone from the wait list.

Since September 11, 2001, Nelson Mullins has provided free wills to first responders in South Carolina, Georgia, Tennessee, and West Virginia through the Wills for Heroes Program.
