# NEW: Pick up your membership card at Fire-Rescue




### Improvement Conference is next month

Nearly everyone has heard "**you can't train enough for a job that can kill you**" and it's true. The time and effort you put into training for the different scenarios you face can save a life. The hands-on-training offered at Fire Service Improvement Conference helps prepare you for those situations.

#### Class spotlight: How To Assess Wildfire Risk in Your Community

This 2-day workshop will help students develop the skills necessary to identify, evaluate and mitigate the wildfire risk associated with their community. They will be given access to programs like SouthWRAP and Community Assessor that can be used to determine risk and vulnerability in a given area. This workshop will also give a hands-on lesson in completing wildfire risk assessments for structures which can be completed for individual homeowners throughout their communities to ensure that residents can reduce their risk as well. We will also look a Community Wildfire Protection Plans (CWPPs) to ensure the students understand the importance of these plans on a broad spectrum and discuss grant opportunities that can support the development of these plans.
