


Happy Thanksgiving! No Rattle Watch next week

Grain Bin Rescue, January 18-19, 2024 during Fire Service Improvement Conference, is for emergency responders who may be called to rescue someone trapped in a grain bin or at a grain handling or storage facility.

Grain bin accidents can be incredibly dangerous if not approached with the proper training and equipment. This course is designed to provide emergency responders with the knowledge and skills needed to carry out a safe and effective rescue operation, covering topics such as teamwork, communication, and incident command. Grain Bin Rescue equips emergency responders with the awareness and abilities necessary to handle the unique challenges of grain bin rescues.

Save the Date for the Firefighter Memorial Service





New NVFC training resource available

Volunteer and combination fire departments face a significant challenge in ensuring their members receive adequate training. These departments often have limited resources, including time, facilities, and funding, making regular and comprehensive training a challenge.

Volunteers may have full time jobs, family obligations, live far from the station, or have other commitments that may further limit their availability to attend training. As a result, providing adequate training for volunteers is a difficult task—but necessary for them and the community you serve.

The National Volunteer Fire Council (NVFC) and International Association of Fire Chiefs' Volunteer and Combination Officers Section (VCOS)'s Training Volunteer Firefighters manual aims to provide volunteer and combination departments with a training roadmap, outlining delivery methods, the role of the training officer, and training policies and procedures.
