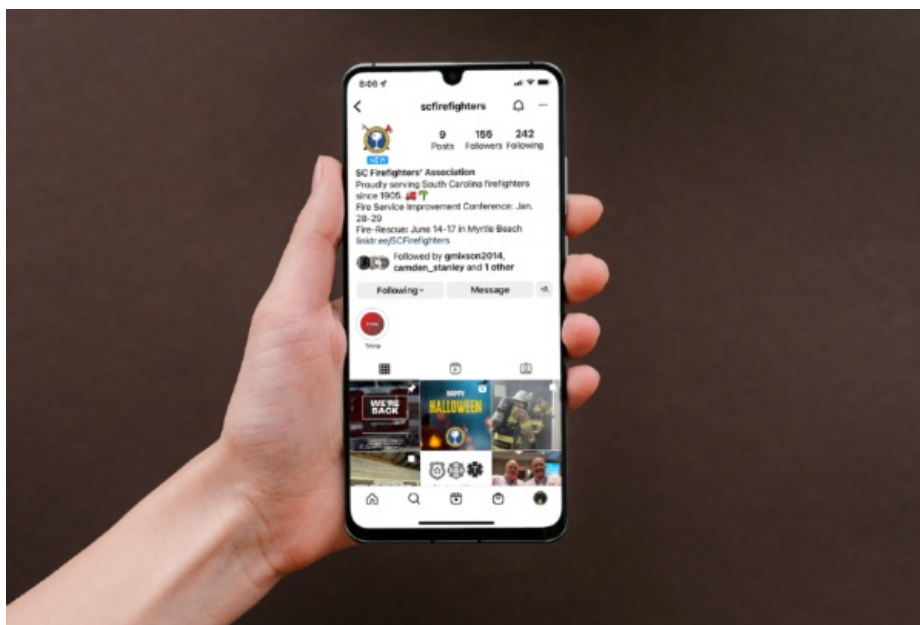
## Parker FD golf tournament a success
