- Kevin Henson wanted assurance we are 100% sure that the SCSFA would be able to meet the mortgage for the facility.
 - Director Helms was to investigate the Association's financial security and report back to the group prior. However, he felt the mortgage could be funded but was unable to provide information on the utilities and any other hidden cost. That information was being requested of the Seller. Director Helms would continue to evaluate.
- Pierce Womack wanted to ensure that we factor in how the purchase of the building will impact the workload and how will the purchase of the facility impact the budget. Question was proposed, would any service, staff or member programs be negatively impacted?
 - Director Helms felt confident that there would be no negative impact to staff or member programs. He would continue to evaluate.
