Old Business

On Tuesday the Executive Committee voting members met with the Fire Chief's association board. We had a good meeting; we want to move forward with building better communications with them. The following day after our meeting the Fire Chief's Association held their quarterly meeting. Our very own 4th VP Kevin Henson was their guest speaker and did an outstanding job. We will have representation at the Chief's conference and will continue to sale the memorial bricks. Chief Brian Moon will have a coin board for us to give away. It was requested that going forward we build into our budget funding to attend their meetings and conferences.

Messer Rescue Squad update by Executive Director Helms, this group has applied to become a member but doesn't meet the requirements for a regularly organized department. A survey has been sent to them asking specific questions, we are awaiting their response.

We need to tighten down on our end the definitions of Fire Department and firefighter, as those are very complex.

Director Helms gave an update that Wagner Fire Department is being investigated by SLED, we have sent Jeff Oswald to do an audit with 1%.

We met with Dominion's representatives Richard Dickerson & Jonathan Yarborough, they do a grant process in NC & VA and they are wanting to start it here in SC. This is for Volunteer FD in their coverage area. This would not disqualify you form VSAFE.

Brick Lewis- presented this year's 1% premium and broker tax numbers. Most everyone received an increase this year. We have purchased a new vehicle we are in the process of getting it titled and tagged. We have added a department associate membership form to the website.

Fire Rescue Data presented by Brick Lewis We had a total of 6,164 people at the 2024 Fire–Rescue Conference.

Training & Education - The T & E Committee remained unchanged and after the meeting with President Arant who provided his expectations, vision, and goals, that information was provided to the committee.
