Fire Chief LeRoy Smith retired from the Prince George's County, Maryland Fire Department after 22 years of service. LeRoy joined the PGFD on September 26, 1988. As an Assistant Fire Chief, he served in the Training Division, supervising new recruit classes and company officer development. Upon completion of his time at the academy he was assigned to county wide tour commander Duty Chief 800.
